### Specific Symptoms

#### Depression Symptoms

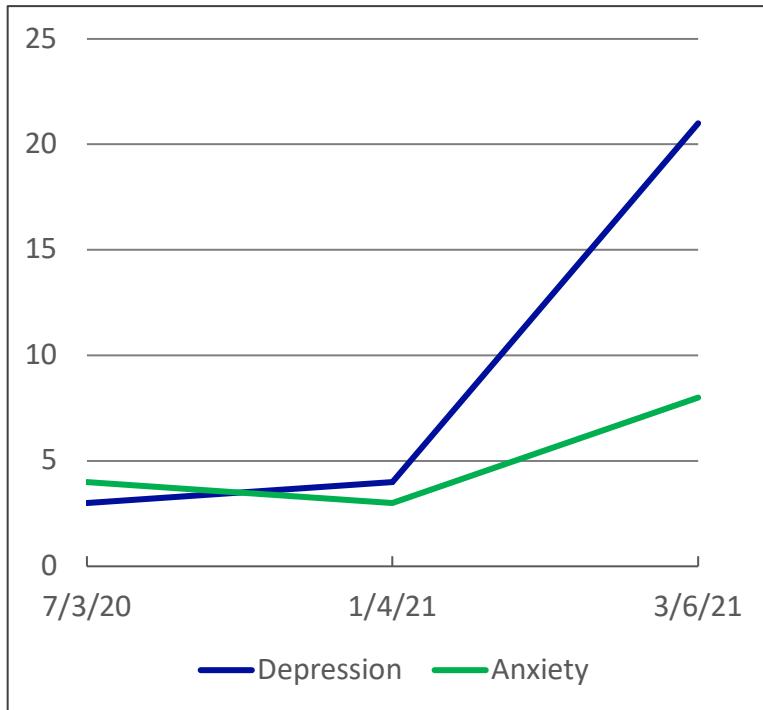
- depressed mood, nearly every day, 2 weeks or longer duration
- diminished interest or pleasure in activities, 2 weeks or longer duration
- weight loss
- insomnia
- fatigue, loss of energy
- feelings of worthlessness or guilt
- impaired concentration
- diminished self-esteem
- hopelessness

### PTSD Symptoms

- intrusive recollections of traumatic event
- distressing dreams of traumatic event
- relives or has flashbacks of traumatic event
- distress or physiological reactivity when reminded of traumatic event
